#### CALL ROOMS

### Call Rooms (Sleep Rooms, Lounge Area)

At Long Beach Memorial Medical Center/Miller Children's Hospital, residents *on call* are provided with adequate and appropriate sleeping quarters that are safe, quiet, and private.

## Where Is My Call Room?

| OB/GYN            | 2 <sup>nd</sup> floor in Labor & Delivery area     |
| Family Medicine   | 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor MCH                          |
| Pediatrics        | 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor MCH                          |
| Podiatry          | 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor MCH or 7 <sup>th</sup> floor |
| Surgery           | 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor MCH                          |
| Urology           | 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor                              |

#### **Directions to Call Rooms**

2<sup>nd</sup> Floor: Take the birth care elevators and go through the double doors. Walk straight and

on the left you will see a door with keypad. Enter code to main door.

3<sup>rd</sup> Floor: Take the MCH main elevators to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Exit the elevator and turn left.

Make a right as soon as you pass the public phones go down the hallway and the

call room will be the third and fourth door on the left.

7<sup>th</sup> Floor: Take main LBMMC elevator to the 7<sup>th</sup> floor. Exit the elevator and turn right.

Enter the double doors and the call room will be the 1<sup>st</sup> door straight ahead with

keypad. Enter code to main door.
